## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

**Dr. Ramdayal Munda Tribal Welfare Research Institute (TRI), Jharkhand**

And

**St. Xavier's College, Ranchi**

---

### 1. Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 30 day of April 2026, between:

**Dr. Ramdayal Munda Tribal Welfare Research Institute (TRI), Jharkhand**, established in 1953 under the Department of Scheduled Tribe, Scheduled Caste, Minority and Backward Class Welfare, Government of Jharkhand, having its office at Morabadi, Ranchi, Jharkhand (hereinafter referred to as "TRI"),

AND

**St. Xavier's College, Ranchi**, an autonomous institution affiliated to Ranchi University, Ranchi, located at Dr. Camil Bulke Path, Ranchi, Jharkhand (hereinafter referred to as "SXC").

Both institutions shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as "the Parties".

---

### 2. Purpose of the MoU

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaborative framework under which SXC shall provide student interns to TRI for academic training, research exposure, fieldwork engagement, documentation and capacity-building activities related to tribal studies, policy research, development interventions and allied domains.

---

### 3. Objectives

The key objectives of this collaboration are:

1. To provide practical exposure and field-based learning opportunities to students of SXC.
2. To support TRI's ongoing research, documentation, digital initiatives, surveys and outreach programmes.
3. To promote academic collaboration in the field of tribal studies, social sciences, public policy, digital governance, anthropology, economics and related disciplines.

4. To strengthen institutional linkages between academia and research institutions in Jharkhand.

---

#### 4. Scope of Collaboration

The collaboration under this MoU shall include, but not be limited to:

- Placement of undergraduate and postgraduate students as interns at TRI.
- Participation of interns in:
  - Research projects and surveys
  - Documentation and archival work
  - Field visits to tribal communities
  - Digital content development and translation
  - Data analysis and report preparation
- Joint academic interactions such as lectures, workshops, seminars and conferences.

---

#### 5. Roles and Responsibilities

##### 5.1 Responsibilities of St. Xavier's College (SXC)

1. To identify and recommend eligible students for internship at TRI.
2. To ensure that selected student meet academic and disciplinary standards.
3. To provide necessary academic credits, if applicable, as per university norms.
4. To brief students regarding institutional ethics, professional conduct and confidentiality requirements.

##### 5.2 Responsibilities of Tribal Research Institute (TRI)

1. To provide meaningful internship assignments aligned with TRI's mandate and projects.
2. To assign a mentor/supervisor to guide interns during their tenure.
3. To provide necessary orientation and access to relevant resources.
4. To issue an Internship Completion Certificate upon satisfactory completion of the internship.

## 6. Duration of Internship

- Internship duration shall generally range from 4 weeks to 12 weeks, depending upon academic requirements and project needs.
- Specific timelines shall be mutually agreed upon prior commencement of each batch of interns.

---

## 7. Financial Provisions

- This MoU does not create any financial obligation between the parties.
- Internship positions shall ordinarily be unpaid unless otherwise informed by TRI and consent given by SXC
- Any financial support, if provided, shall be governed by separate written communication.

---

## 8. Confidentiality

Interns shall maintain confidentiality of any sensitive data, research findings, unpublished reports or official information accessed during their internship. Disclosure without prior written consent of TRI shall not be permitted.

---

## 9. Intellectual Property

Any intellectual property arising out of work undertaken by interns at TRI shall ordinarily vest with TRI, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing.

---

## 10. Review and Monitoring

Both Parties may periodically review the implementation of this MoU and suggest improvements to enhance effectiveness and impact.

---

## 11. Validity and Termination

- This MoU shall remain valid for a period of **One (01) year** from the date of signing.
- It may be renewed upon mutual consent.
- Either party may terminate this MoU by giving **one (01) month** written notice to the other party.
